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Annual Sports Day at PEN adopted Nishat High School Sports

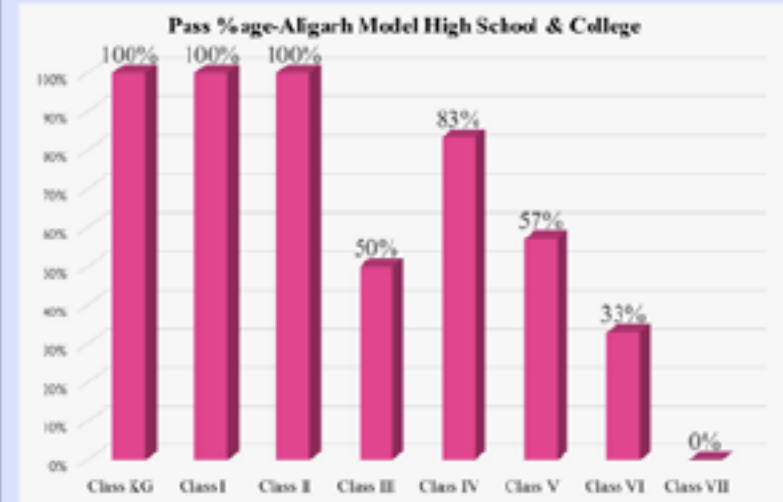

Every teacher needs to improve not because they are not good

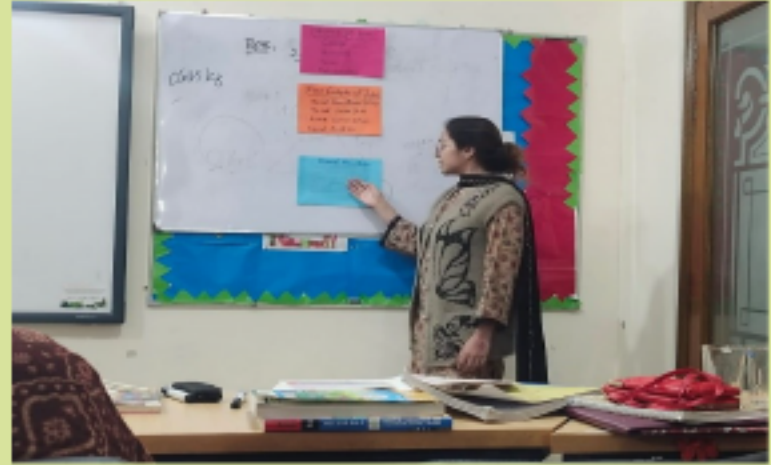

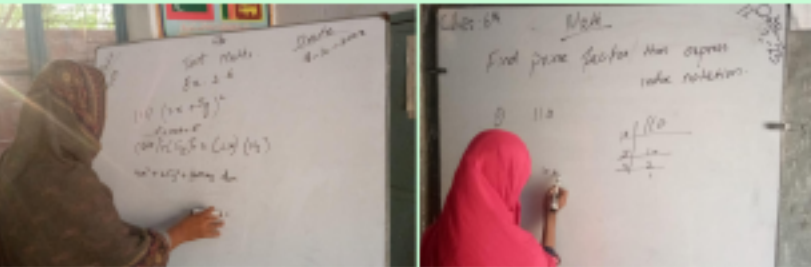
Training Session on Micro Teaching
