

PEN - Empowering Children Through Education


Progressive Education Network (PEN) is a professionally managed Not-for-Profit Organization registered in 2005 with the Securities & Exchange Commission of Pakistan. Its main objective is to provide quality and value-based education to the under-privileged children of Pakistan, aiming to make them harbingers of change in society for economic prosperity and tolerance in attitudes.


So far, PEN has actualized this vision by adopting 292 public schools with an enrolment of 75,615 students across twenty five (25) districts of Pakistan and transforming them into centers of quality learning.

PEN makes improvements at these schools to tackle problems of poor infrastructure due to limitation in resources, lack of academic achievement resulting from lack of trained teachers and opportunity gaps due to social issues. Far too often, schools lack even the bare essentials, and PEN plays a key role to forge a productive and meaningful learning experience to ensure that children can reach their potential.

PEN rolled out its first activity in 2010 by creating a conducive learning environment in 23 public schools in Lahore. The drive has now extended to Sindh and Islamabad in a bid to reach public schools all over the country.


Remote Areas
