PSRP-1: PEN ADOPTED 28 NEW SCHOOLS OF SARGODHA & BAHAWALNAGAR DISTRICT





Strengthening Quality Education


- National Commission for Human Development representative visited 78 schools and encouraged PEN's efforts in areas of quality education, student enrollment and sanitation.

PEN students are united with their Kashmiri brothers for their struggle of freedom. We believe that every individual has right to live with freedom and respect.


TEACHERS DAY
