
# TEACHERS' PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (TPDP) - SUMMER

RENEWAL OF APPROVAL UNDER SECTION 2(36) OF THE INCOME TAX ORDINANCE, 2001 READ WITH RULE 212 OF THE INCOME TAX RULES, 2002 – PROGRESSIVE EDUCATION NETWORK NTN: 2279174 PROGRESSIVE EDUCATION NETWORK NTN: 2279174 (hereinafter referred to as the applicant) have applied for renewal of approval under Section 2(36) of the Income Tax Ordinance, 2001 through Iris vide barcode 100000198100980, dated 25.06.2024 for tax year 2025.

In order to evaluate the performance of the applicant in terms of clause (g) of sub-rule (2) of Rule 211 of the Income Tax Rules, 2002, a committee consisting of departmental officers was constituted. The Committee evaluated the performance under the relevant provisions of the Income Tax Ordinance, 2001 and the Income Tax Rules, 2002 and submitted its report vide letter bearing No. Zone-I/197 dated 27.08.2024 and has proposed that the applicant may be granted of renewal of approval as a Non-Profit Organization under section 2(36) of the Ordinance.

I have given due consideration to the record and report submitted by the committee and I am of the opinion that the applicant duly complies with the requirements of the relevant Income Tax Rules and merits approval under section 2(36) of the Ordinance. Therefore, the applicants request for granted renewal of approval as a Non-Profit Organization is hereby approved subject to following conditions:

1. This approval is valid for a period of One Tax year i.e. for Tax year 2025 and shall expire on 30-06-2025 unless withdrawn earlier.
2. The taxpayer has also been certified by the PCP vide their Certification No. PCP-/2021/923 dated 30.12.2021 with the validity upto 30.12.2024.
3. The applicant shall apply afresh under the prescribed rules for re-evaluation of its status as a Non-Profit Organization in terms of Section 2(36) of the Ordinance at the end of the expiry period.
4. During the period mentioned at Serial No.1, the NPO shall comply with all the relevant provisions and rules including Section 100C of the Income Tax Ordinance, 2001 and Chapter XVII of the Income Tax Rules, 2002. In case of violation of any legal provisions or relevant rules, the approval shall stand withdrawn ab-initio.


